Cleantech is one of the bright spots in the recovering world economy and is attracting substantial investments. President Obama and the new US Administration have specifically targeted Cleantech for growth and funding. This will attract leading European Cleantech Companies that want to become active in the US.

European-American Chambers of Commerce and business groups in New England are organizing the second annual Boston Cleantech Venture Day (BCVD) to assist European Cleantech companies in exploring and taking advantage of opportunities in the U.S. It is generally recognized that European Cleantech companies frequently are ahead and take a global leadership role in Cleantech.

European Cleantech companies are invited to present capabilities, business plans and achievements in Europe to American venture capitalists, corporate investors and potential business partners. EVENT FORMAT

European Cleantech companies will be given 20 minutes to present at the conference. Highly respected keynote speakers, representing investors and businesses focused on Cleantech will make presentations on the latest trends in the industry. SELECTION PROCESS

European Cleantech companies will be selected based on their promise, uniqueness of technology, market validation, and management experience. The Investor Advisory Board, which will select presenting companies, consists of experienced venture capitalists, management/technology consultants and Cleantech experts.

COST

The cost for each attendee is \$395. Attendees who are members of any of the sponsoring European Chambers of Commerce or business groups are offered a reduced fee of \$195 to attend the BCVD.

For attendees that sign up and pay prior to September 30th the cost is \$295.
